### **Stewardship Financial Update - February 2022**

Thank you to everyone for your 2022 financial commitments. Our 2022 operating budget projects a shortfall of around 6% which we can manage with continued vigilance in controlling our expenses combined with modest growth in membership and giving.

We budget income and expenses for each month of the year. So many people pay their entire yearly pledges in January, that it is the only month where budgeted income is greater than budgeted expenses. Therefore, showing you actual income and expenses would be misleading.

We have instead chosen to show how actual income and expenses turned out compared to our monthly and year-to-date budget. In the table below, February income came in at \$3,279 less than our budget and expenses were \$3,263 less than budget, resulting in a net \$16 shortfall compared to budget. Year-to-date our income is \$3,738 under budget and expenses are \$4,947 under budget, resulting in a net \$1,209 positive variance to date. Our \$1,209 year-to-date variance means that we are currently tracking to lose only \$53,218 instead of \$54,427.





to pack rather than just donate to the meals. Each bag that is packed costs \$1.74 and is enough for 6 meals. This year we will also have a church- wide rice lunch (very similar to



what we are packing) right after church and then head down to pack some meals. We encourage folks to donate what you would usually spend when you go out to eat, to be used for providing the meals. We will have a collection after church on March 27, to raise money so that we know how many supplies LifeLine needs to bring for us to pack. We will have the youth and kids packing during youth group and ROCK that night.
