Exceptionally Ordinary

Joshua 1:9 – yet the most common Biblical command is "Do not be afraid"

Matthew 28:20 – we need not fear because God is with us always

Confirmation, baptism, and communion underscore that God is with us in the everyday

Questions for Reflection: What if Jesus's warnings about keeping watch were not intended as a cause for fear? We are to keep watch, like we watch the sky for signs about the weather, for signs that God is at work in the world around us. What if Jesus wanted us to be alert so that we didn't miss God while our attention was zeroed in on the day-to-day? Each day this week, write down one time you saw the caring, providing, or encouraging hand of God at work in your life or around you.

<u>Questions for Discussion:</u> What's one time that God showed up in your life through what is otherwise a common, mundane activity? A meal? A quiet moment?

Memory Verse: Luke 24:30-31 – "When he was at the table with them, he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him; and he vanished from their sight."
