<u>Luke 2:19</u> – "But Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart."

For me, the Christmas season is often a blur. There's a rush to get ready for worship services, wrapping presents at home, trying to fit in friends and family and so many things. By the time we get to the candlelight services on Christmas Eve, I find the peaceful and reflective liturgy and songs to be so refreshing. It mirrors the serenity that Mary embodied on that night so many years ago.

This year, Dean and Pastor Mike and I have been preparing for Advent hoping to make space for that reflective, peaceful sense over the whole season. Each week, we'll take a glimpse of what may have been in the heart of



one of the witnesses to that first Christmas night. I know that you'll find some of the joy and peace that Jesus gives through this season of worship. I'd encourage you invite someone to join you who could benefit from experiencing that Christmas peace this year.

In addition, some of us are looking for a way that we can explore and experience the magic of Christmas even more deeply. I'd invite you to a four week Advent study that we'll be hosting here at First Church on Thursdays at 6 pm during Advent, starting December 1. We'll be sharing some devotional reflections based on the Advent series, "From Generation to Generation" by A Sanctified Art. The other pastors from Church Square and I will be taking turns leading.



"Is the UMC Really..."

Over the last six months, some misleading information has been shared online about the United Methodist Church by those who are choosing to leave and start a new denomination. United Methodist Communications has put together a very helpful resource that addresses six of these misleading bits of information. I've included the link at the end of this article. I believe that this is a valuable resource to keep us all informed of the truth about our Church.

Our survey in September was the last thing we'll be doing before General Conference meets in 2024 on the matter of proposed changes to the denomination regarding the ordination of LGBTQ+ inclusion and same-sex

marriage. Those of you who participated shared your views and we are grateful for your having done so. The lay and clergy leaders of First Church are using those results to guide the steps we take as a congregation over the next few years. If you didn't get a chance to participate and would like to, give me a call or email and I'll walk you through things. If the 2024 General Conference makes any changes to LGBTQ+ inclusion, we will consider how our congregation might be engaged in further discussion **at that time**, possibly in some form of voluntary small group gatherings.



In addition, the clergy and lay leaders who comprise our church council have been in dialogue with a person in our congregation who has become convinced of some of this incorrect information that is being shared online. You may have received an invitation to a Facebook group by this person where these things are being shared. You may also receive a letter from him in the near future which includes some of this misleading information. Before that might happen, I wanted to make sure you have the correct information about the United Methodist Church and First Church. If you have any further concerns or questions, please reach out.
