This past Sunday, we had two beautiful services of worship! At 8:30, we celebrated World Communion Sunday with Pastor Pippin bringing a powerful reminder of the nurturing and barrier-breaking community that Jesus built by giving his earthly body to create a new community, the Body of Christ.

At 10:30, we gathered for worship with all five congregations that worship and serve Christ in the central downtown Cuyahoga Falls area. Six clergy from the five denominations shared in leading worship for over three hundred persons online and in-person. We heard the Gospel read in Nepali and English, Father Brian from the Episcopal Church challenged us to faithfully consider all that we do in light of what Jesus would do. We celebrated communion musically in the service with two choirs, strings and woodwinds, piano and organ!

church on these dates and come back for the big sale on Friday and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. All profits go to a variety of local and national missions.



Thursday (13th from 9 a.m.– 2 p.m. - Chandeliers lowered so that globes can be set aside and sockets repaired

Friday (14th, anytime from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.) - to finish socket repair.

Saturday (15th) - Clean the glass globes and crank the chandeliers back up. If you have never seen what is above the sanctuary, now is your chance!

We will supply gloves so that finger oils don't hurt the brass chandelier metal. We will have some tools, but if
