One hundred ninety-four years ago, a Methodist Episcopal circuit rider began to stop at a school building near where Moe's Restaurant is now located at Front Street and Wadsworth Ave. In 1837, the newly forming city of Cuya-

hoga Falls laid out the land between Stow Ave and Portage Trail and 2<sup>nd</sup> and  $3^{rd}$  streets for a public square and religious, educational, or governmental purposes. By 1840, a wood frame building was ready for us, next to St. John's Episcopal church. We shared the square with this



congregation and a school until sometime after 1856, then a congregational church moved into a building where First Christian stands today.

For these nearly two centuries, our congregations have provided a spiritual presence at the heart of our city. We have cared for the hungry, healed the hurting, given glory to God through worship, and witnessed to God's goodness where we stand together. In that spirit, over the years we have also worshipped together on occasion. Starting in 2018, we began to expand these opportunities to Lenten services, a combined service at the riverfront, and Bible studies through Advent and Lent.

Last Tuesday, I shared with the congregational leaders that those experiences of worshipping, serving, and learning together have developed into some possible new shared vision for our congregations. We have begun conversations with our neighbors and our city about what it could look like to redevelop our block to maximize our shared ability to meet the present needs of our community in the name of Jesus. At a time when our society seems to find new ways to divide itself every time the calendar page turns, these discussions give me hope that we can communicate that another way of collaboration among Christians is possible.

Nothing has been decided as we are in a discussion and discernment phase. As the conversations develop this year, we'll continue to keep you in the loop. There will certainly be opportunities to participate, give feedback, and dream together in time. For now, I encourage you to pray for discernment, courage, and that God's will be done. Please reach out to me if you'd like to hear more about this.
