



The next General Conference of The United Methodist Church will convene at the Charlotte Convention Center in Charlotte, North Carolina, April 23 – May 3, 2024, with delegates from Africa, Europe, Asia and the United States participating.

The General Conference is the top policy-making body of The United Methodist Church. The assembly meets to consider revisions to church law, as well as adopt resolutions on current moral, social, public policy, and economic issues.

The last General Conference was set to happen in Minneapolis, Minnesota, in 2020 until the pandemic made it necessary to postpone the quadrennial legislative event until 2024.
