A Note from the Pastor

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 - Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

According to recent research on happiness, one of the greatest contributors to our happiness is how much gratitude we show in life. When you get a chance, check out this YouTube video where the folks over at Soul Pancake test out that research (http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oHv6vTKD6lg).

So, saying thank you is actually good for the soul. Perhaps this is why the Bible repeats the instruction "Give Thanks" so often. By my count, this phrase occurs no less than 33 times throughout Scripture. We are to give thanks because God is good, and His love endures forever (1 Chronicles 16:34), because it's God's will for us to give thanks (1 Thessalonians 5:18), and even because it can be a remedy for our anxious souls (Philippians 4:6).

So, those scientists (the guy in the video was at least wearing a labcoat...) found the Biblical truth of Thanksgiving to be integral to our happiness. But, they pointed out two other things that are pretty interesting. First, when we're down the most, gratitude can give us the biggest boost. People in the study who were the least happy before they expressed gratitude experienced the greatest increases in happiness (sounds like Philippians 4:6 to me!).

Second, they found that actually saying that you're thankful to the person that you're thankful to resulted in the greatest benefits to happiness. So, it's one thing to be thankful, but a whole other ball game when we actually tell someone that we are thankful for them or something they did.

This gave me an idea: let's try it out. From the day you read this until Thanksgiving Day (Nov. 28, this year), say thank you to someone at least once a day. Maybe being every prayer with at least one thing for which you're thankful to God. Say it in person when someone helps you with something, write a thankfulness journal for the next few weeks, post a thank you on Facebook or Twitter each day, or send a card and call a person who was a big influence in your life. I'll start. Thanks for taking the time to read this!

In a few weeks, you'll receive your annual stewardship materials. We'll share our gratitude for the ways that your generosity has enabled the ministry and life of First Church. Maybe supporting your church is a way that you express your gratitude to God in 2025. Thank you for giving God your prayers, your presence, your gifts, your service, and your witness through First Church!
